

Visit The Economy Museum

At the Economy Museum you can explore what money and economy are, have been and can be.

Take a journey through Sweden's history and discover how money and economics shaped society and transformed people's lives. Among the 3,000 objects on display are fascinating treasures, Sweden's first banknotes, and a bitcoin ATM. See the world's largest coin and try lifting a replica. You can also do a fictional job interview to see what job you would have had if you had lived in the 1800s.

- June – August: 10.00 – 17.00
- September – May: 11.00 – 17.00, Wednesdays 11.00 – 20.00

Admission

- Adults: 180 SEK
- Children/youth up to 18 years: Free
- Wednesdays 5 PM – 8 PM 90 SEK
- Half price during the last hour, 4 PM – 5 PM SEK 90 (not valid on Wednesday evenings)
- Guides/tour leaders: Free
- Admission to the Economy Museum located in the same building is included in the ticket.

Recommended visit duration: 1 – 2.5 hours

- Weekdays: 1 200 SEK + 180 SEK per additional person
